Understanding EHCPs and Annual Reviews

An Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) is a legal document that supports children and young people with significant special educational needs (SEN) or disabilities. It sets out their individual needs and the extra help they need to achieve their potential.

Each year, the EHCP is reviewed to make sure it still meets your child's needs and reflects their future goals. We strongly encourage parents and carers to take part in this process by attending the review meeting and sharing your views on what's working well and what might need to change.

Annual reviews last about an hour and are held on Tuesdays in person at SAIL and on Thursdays via Teams. If, when you receive your email notification, you are unable to make the date/time offered, please contact Niki at send-team@sail-academy.org as soon as possible. We will always try to accommodate requests but as we continue to grow it may not always be possible.


