PSHE/RSE Curriculum

At SAIL Academy, we are committed to delivering a high-quality Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) curriculum that supports every student's personal development and wellbeing. A key element of this provision is our Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), which plays an essential role in helping children and young people form healthy, respectful and positive relationships.

Our RSE curriculum equips students with the knowledge, confidence and skills they need to make informed, responsible and ethical decisions about their health, wellbeing and future. Because these topics are so important, we want to ensure our approach is transparent, age-appropriate and developed in partnership with parents and carers.

We have attached our most up-to-date RSE policy — also available on our website — alongside an overview of the full PSHE curriculum. This outline shows the sequenced units taught across each year group, ensuring students receive the right information at the right time and build a strong foundation for lifelong learning and personal development.

Currently, students in Years 8, 10 and 11 are studying RSE/Health Education content, with Year 9 due to begin this learning next term. The curriculum overview provides a detailed breakdown of the specific topics covered at each stage.
