### Trips

Recently, our Turtles, Starfish and Shark groups have been to Dorchester to visit the Dorset County Museum to boost our geological knowledge of fossils and Mary Anning our local Victorian palaeontologist. Over the road, is the Tutankhamun Exhibition, that helped close last term's study of Ancient Egypt.

Meanwhile Angelfish pupils supported by Shark pupils, spent this Monday at Harnham Water Meadows on a lovely weather and seasons focus session to wrap up their topic. As part of their new 'creators' topic we also saw how the clever watermen of the past, 'drown' the meadows using a series of hatch gates – this defrosts the grass in winter to allow an early crop for animals.

#### Careers – the fire station!

Our KS3 students had a brilliant time visiting Salisbury Fire Station as part of their careers education. They learned about the different roles within the fire and rescue service and what it takes to become a firefighter. Students took part in a range of hands-on activities, including climbing the ladder, using the hose reel, and learning about the equipment used in emergencies. The highlight for many was getting a well-deserved soaking on a very hot day—great fun and well-earned! It was an engaging and informative visit that helped students understand the skills, teamwork, and dedication involved in this vital career.
