


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School Nurse Poster

FUEL programme – Easter 2025 - reminder

We are delighted that the Department for Education has confirmed funding for the FUEL programme to run at Easter, Summer and Christmas in 2025. The programme is funded to provide activities and meals free of charge for children who are eligible for benefit related Free School Meals.

All families who have previously booked onto the programme will be notified directly when booking is open.

Places can also be requested for children who are refugees, are in care, are young carers or who may be vulnerable during the school holidays. The number of places available for these



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children are limited so if you are interested please look to book as soon as you can
